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RoHS and RoHS 3 Certificate of Compliance

Heyco Products Corp. hereby certifies, based on supplier declarations and internal material composition data, that its products comply with the requirements of:

- Directive 2011/65/EU – Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS Recast)
- Directive (EU) 2015/863 – Amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 3)

These Directives restrict the presence of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) placed on the EU market.

Restricted Substances and Maximum Concentration Values

Under RoHS and RoHS 3, the following ten substances are restricted to the Maximum Trace Levels (MTL) listed below, by weight in homogeneous materials:

Substance	Maximum Concentration
Cadmium (Cd)	0.01% (100 ppm)
Lead (Pb)	0.1% (1000 ppm)*
Mercury (Hg)	0.1% (1000 ppm)
Hexavalent Chromium (Cr ⁶⁺)	0.1% (1000 ppm)
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)	0.1% (1000 ppm)
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)	0.1% (1000 ppm)
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1% (1000 ppm)
Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1% (1000 ppm)
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1% (1000 ppm)
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1% (1000 ppm)

¹ Lead exemptions apply as defined in Annex III of Directive 2011/65/EU.

Metal Components

Certain products contain copper alloy components (including brass) that may contain lead as an alloying element.

- Lead content does not exceed the limits permitted under RoHS Annex III, Exemption 6(c)
- Exemption 6(c) permits up to 4.0% lead in copper alloys where technically necessary

China RoHS (SJ/T 11363-2006 and SJ/T 11364-2006)

Molded products supplied by Heyco Products Corp. do not contain hazardous substances above defined concentration limits. Metal stamped products comply with applicable lead concentration limits or permitted exemptions.

No additional marking or labeling is required under China RoHS at this time
